The Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requires federal agencies in the executive branch to disclose records to the public (with a number of specific exemptions). Unfortunately, managing requests for information can become a complex, time-consuming endeavor. In addition, agencies are required to produce regular detailed reports to show that they are complying with the FOIA—which becomes another complex, time-consuming task.

The entellitrak FOIA solution simplifies every step of a FOIA request, for both the requesting party and the knowledge worker responding to the request. For the public, the system supports a user-friendly, web-based portal that makes it easy to submit requests. Your agency can create templates for automatically-generated response letters to acknowledge the request, and to keep the requesting citizen apprised of the status as you move through the process.

Managing Documents

Not only can the entellitrak FOIA solution track and manage requests, it can be configured to fulfill them as well. The Document Management module allows users to store, retrieve, preview, redact, annotate, and share documents. It can handle nearly any kind of file so you can deliver everything from contracts, research papers, and reports to presentations and spreadsheets. It can also manage image, video, and audio files.

Interface with FOIA.gov

Individuals may make FOIA requests directly to an agency, or they may go through the FOIA.gov website. The entellitrak FOIA solution can interface with FOIA.gov to let agencies receive and start processing their requests quickly irrespective of their point of origin.

Automation to Simplify Reporting

Each federal agency is required to submit the Annual FOIA Report to the Department of Justice on or before February 1 of each year. When you rely on manual processes and separate systems to store data, it becomes very challenging to collect and collate detailed statistics on the numbers of requests received and processed by the agency, the time taken to respond, the outcome of each request, and other statistics related to the handling of requests.

The entellitrak FOIA solution streamlines the reporting process by capturing and formatting all required data to meet Department of Justice requirements. And because the solution is so easy to configure, if reporting requirements change, those changes can be accommodated easily.
